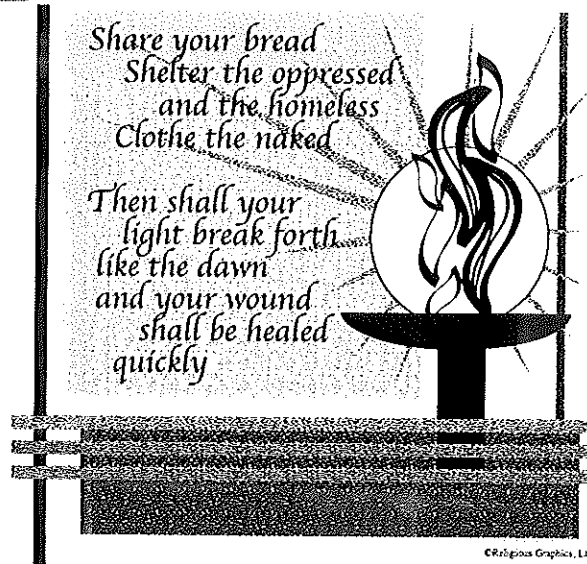

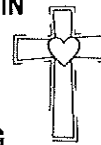

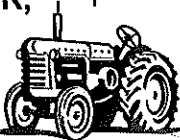

Some of our Shut-Ins would still like to be able to attend Mass. This is a very important Ministry. If you could help in this regard, please call Patty, 242-2174.

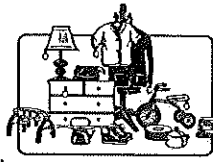
TRANSPORTING PERSONS FOR THERAPY, DOCTORS APPOINTMENTS ETC.
