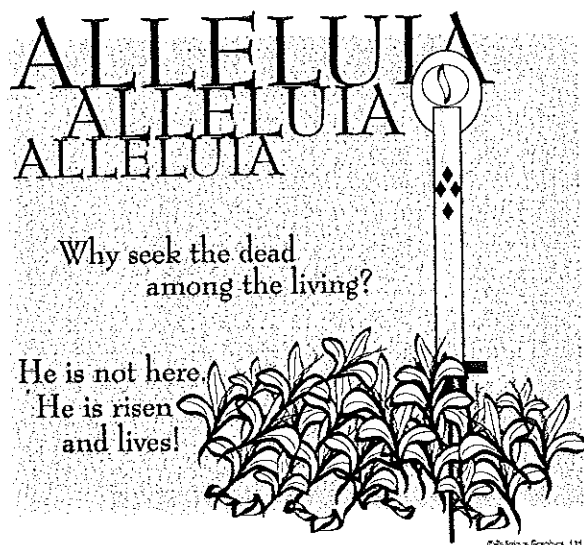

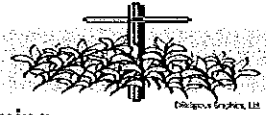

afraid:

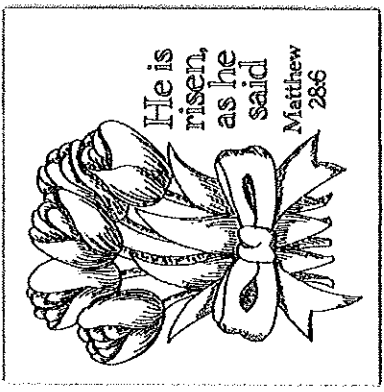
- of serious illness, financial or relationship problems. He has conquered even death, so He can bring good out of any evil we face.
