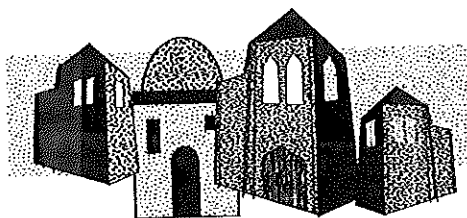

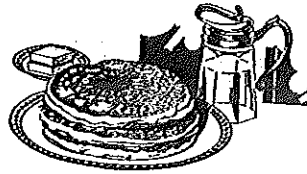
Aside from the obvious mission of participating with God in the creation of life, each parent has a daily mission to make God's love concrete by the way they love their children. How do Dads do this?
