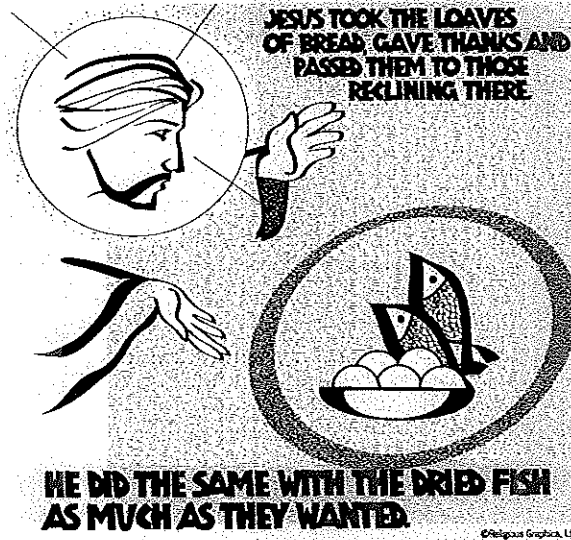

**MARRIAGE MINUTE**

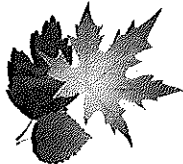
