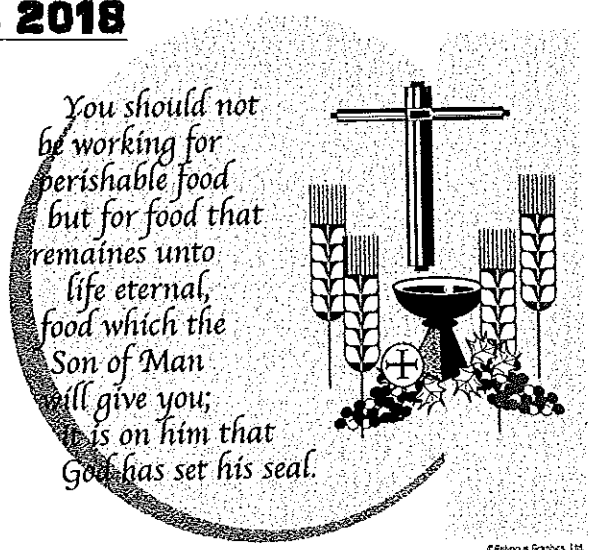

Wednesday, October 24 – Corpus Christi – Lawrence

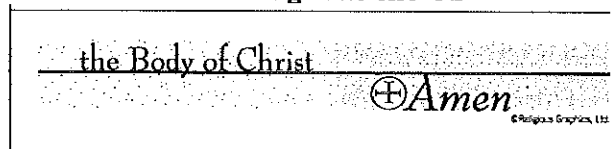
