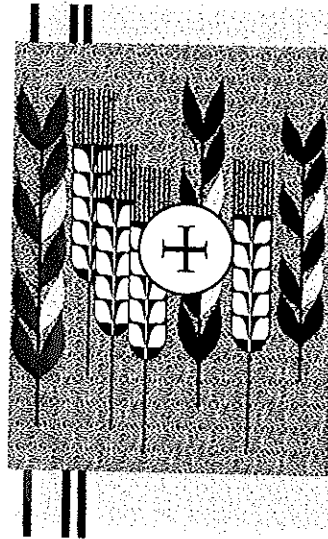

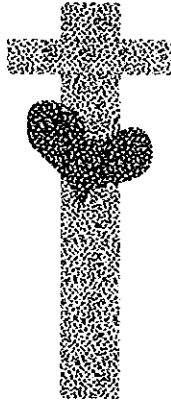

 to make them happen! In this weekend's readings, Wisdom
 invites people for dinner and Jesus feeds us on His own
 Body and Blood. In this context, simple meals together have
 elevated meaning and are opportunities to grow in our faith
 and our love for each other. If scheduling is a challenge, try:

- Get up early and do breakfast together
- Keep one or more nights per week free from outside
 commitments
- Even if everyone can't be present for a meal, pray as
 a group for anyone absent

If you don't have children, or they have left home, don't
 discount the importance of family dinner for you as a couple!
