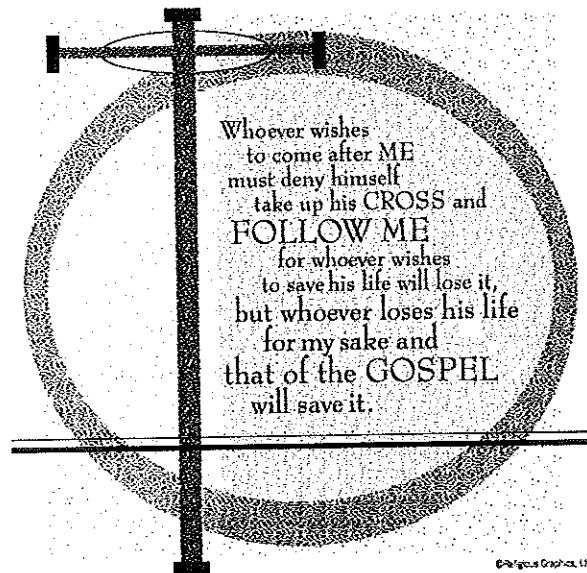

Do You Hear What I Hear?

Being a good listener is a vital part of living our dignity as Christians. Jesus is an attentive and available listener to all who seek Him. Because our marriages imitate Christ's love for the Church, we are called to generously listen to our spouse. How do we do this?

- Be available: Prioritize listening to your spouse by setting aside time each day to connect.
- Be attentive: When listening, give full attention through proper posture and eye contact. And shut off distractions like the phone or tv.
- Be understanding: Demonstrate you understood what he said by repeating back in your own words what was communicated to you
- Be prayerful: Ask God to help you be a better listener

Sacred Heart Church Volunteer Needs List

We are in need of volunteers to take over these ministry positions:

Write the Introduction, Petitions, and Announcements each week for weekend Masses, Holy Days, and Masses for special Feasts.

Sacristan for daily Mass.

Organist for Saturday evening Masses.

Set up Adoration Chapel on Thursday mornings and close up Chapel on Fridays after Benediction, usually 7:45am to 8:05am, Thursday and Fridays.

Sacristan for Funeral Masses (usually 8:00am to 11:30am, depending on time of Funeral), Wake Services, Advent and Lent Penance Services, etc.

Sunday School Teacher for children ages 3-7 years at the 9:00 am Mass Sundays Sept till May each year.

Set up for the Nursing Home Mass at Ottawa Retirement Village on the third Friday of each month. Bring the Residents to the room assigned for the Mass and after Mass, return them to their rooms. Usually 1:15pm till about 2:45pm.

Take Holy Communion to the Homebound on the third and fourth Sundays of each month. Take Holy Communion to the Nursing Home on the fourth Sunday of each month. Keep, and update as needed, the list of the Homebound and Nursing Home Residents who receive Holy Communion each week and the volunteers who help distribute Holy Communion on the weekends. Fill in when volunteers have to be gone.

Assist with counting collection on Monday mornings, usually 9:00am-10:30am.

Organize helpers to change the Missalettes when due each quarter, and also change the Music Books before the start of Advent each November. Take old books to Recycling Center.

Wash server robes (and iron, mend) at least once a year, usually during Spring Break or during the summer. Currently there are 35 robes.

Provide hospitality for RCIA class - make cookies or dessert, etc. and beverages each week on Thursday evenings September thru Easter.
