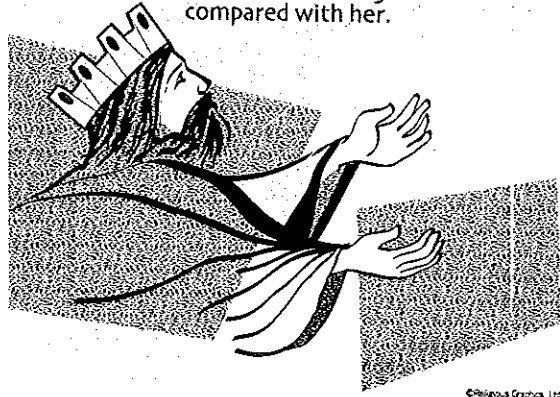

Religious Education Raffle again.

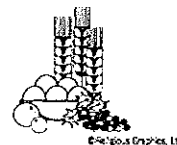
Sacred Heart Council
