Hospitality Sunday will be held on September 29th to celebrate "Priesthood Sunday" (instead of October 6), after both masses.


We will be collecting "ice cream buckets" to be used to store homemade ice cream for Fall Festival. Please bring clean ones to the shelves outside the cry room.


