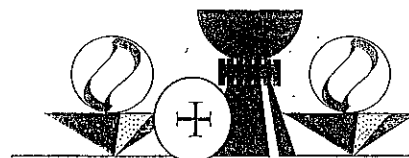

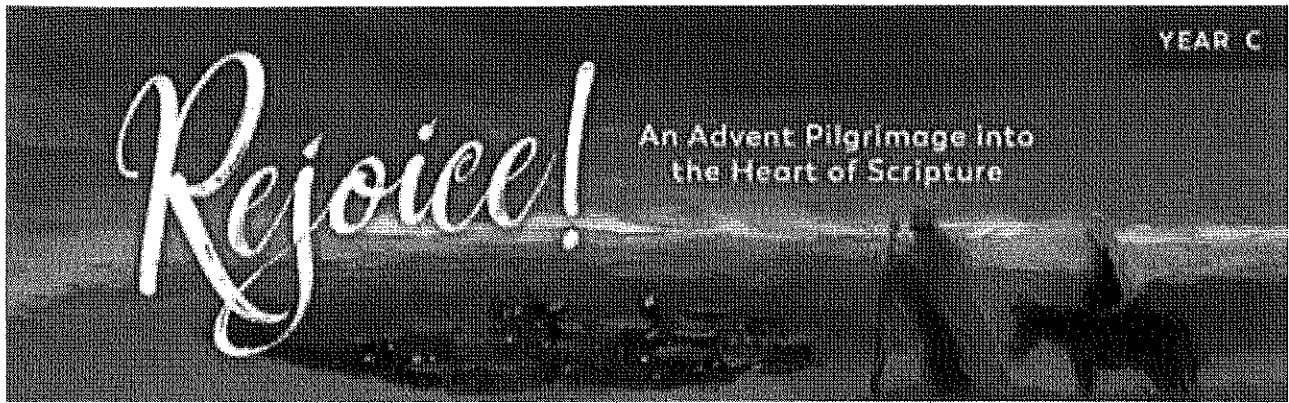

Lord, teach us the true spirit of generosity



Advent is a special season for the Church. It is the time when Christians prepare to celebrate the coming of Christ. We often lose sight of the point of this season because we get so caught up in the festive busyness, and we find ourselves no more transformed on Christmas Day than we were at the start of Advent.

One way our parish is seeking to prepare for Jesus' birth is with a special program from Ascension called *Rejoice! An Advent Pilgrimage into the Heart of Scripture, Year C*. This program features daily reflections, prayer, and opportunities for journaling. It also includes weekly video reflections presented by Fr. Mark Toups and his friends Rebecca Abboud and Fr. Patrick Riviere. In addition, the journal includes weekly activities and resources to help individuals and families enter into the season of Advent.

This Advent, we have an opportunity to walk together as a parish, opening our hearts to hear what God is saying to us in this hectic but blessed season.

Everyone in the parish can participate by picking up one of the provided journals and doing your daily reflection, prayer and journaling each day during Advent. Then you can either 1) participate at the group meetings on Wednesday nights at the Church during Advent to view Fr. Toups video and discuss or 2) you can watch the videos at home.

Each participant will receive a *Rejoice!* journal, filled with beautiful art and meaningful meditations, to use throughout the Advent season.

Rejoice! is an opportunity for our whole community to enter the season of Advent intentionally and receive the grace God is waiting to give us in this sacred time of preparation for Christmas. Join us this Advent Season and take full advantage of this transformative experience.
