




CATHOLIC COUNSELORS LIST

KANSAS CATHOLIC CONFERENCE POLICY PRESENTATION - Kansas Catholics, Politics and the 2024 Election Catholics are called to Faithful Citizenship, which includes voting. How do we apply our faith and a properly formed conscience to the policy issues of the day as well as our choices for elected office? These are timely and important questions as every seat in the Kansas Senate and House is up for election this year. Members of the Kansas Catholic Conference (KCC), the public policy voice of the Kansas Catholic Bishops, are offering two special presentations designed to inform voters about key issues and where candidates stand. The first presentation is set for 7 p.m. on Monday, October 14 at St. Michael the Archangel Church parish hall in Leawood. A second presentation is being offered at 7 p.m. on Monday, October 21 at St. Patrick's Church parish hall in Kansas City.

These presentations will cover what happened this past legislative session at the Kansas Statehouse and information about candidate surveys commissioned by the KCC will be distributed. There will also be time for questions and answers. Please come to help become better informed as you prepare to vote.
