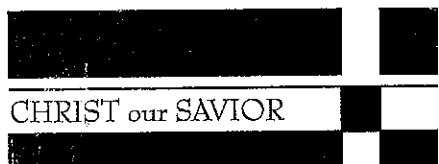

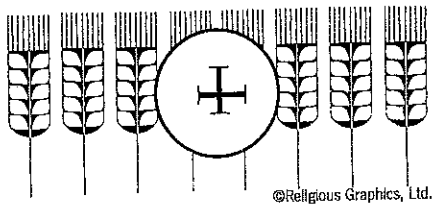

ARCHBISHOP NAUMANN'S HOMILY ON THE ARCHBISHOP'S CALL TO SHARE

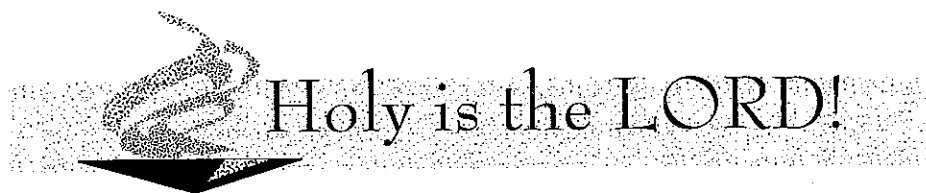

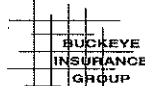
